On the 18/1/2017 (after 9.30am), pre-release for NI Tourism Statistics October 2015 to September 2016 was issued to the standard pre-release access list (see link).

At 5.44pm (18/1/2017), a Dept for Economy official (on the PRA list) issued an email to officials which indicated the numerical direction of the new tourism statistics. This e-mail was sent to some officials on the list but also to four other senior officials not on the pre-release list.

3. Impact of the breach

Provide details of the impact of the breach both inside the producer body and externally

A number of officials not on the pre-release access list became aware of the direction of tourism performance in Northern Ireland prior to the release of the statistics.

The four officials opened and read the e-mail but did not take any action or forward to anyone else. When they were made aware of the breach they deleted the email.

There was no public release before the official publication.

4. Corrective actions (taken or planned) to prevent re-occurrence

Describe the short-term actions made to redress the situation and the longer term changes to procedures etc

NISRA will meet with, issue guidance and a note to the relevant officials in the Dept for Economy to remind them of the protocols regarding official statistics pre-release access.
