2. Circumstances of breach

Relevant principle/protocol and practice	Protocol 2, Practice 4: Issue statistical releases at the standard time of 9.30am on a weekday, to maintain consistency and to permit time for users to understand and respond to the information during normal working hours.

Following the terrorist attack at Westminster Bridge in London on 22 March 2017, Heads of Profession received instructions *via* their departmental communications teams that no publications should be made from GOV.UK for a 24 hour period. This also extended to pre-announced statistics.

3. Impact of the breach

This caused disruption and delay to the publication of 16 statistical releases from 8 government departments. The Government Statistical Service (GSS) enacted business continuity procedures and although there were publishing delays of up to 1 hour 47 minutes, 'business as usual' soon resumed, minimising the overall impact to users.

4. Corrective actions (taken or planned) to prevent re-occurrence

- At 16:41 the National Statistician and the Director General for Regulation were made aware of an issue via an email from a Head of Profession.
- Following discussion with the National Statistician, at 17:12 the National Statistician's
 Private Office informed the ONS Head of Digital Publishing of the situation, asking whether
 it would be feasible to place GSS statistics onto the ONS backup site.
- At 18:23 the Central Policy Secretariat emailed Heads of Profession to alert them to the issue.

At 19:41 the National Statistician's Private Secretary emailed Heads of Profession to say that, after careful consideration, the National Statistician had decided that it was important

- that all statistics which were pre-announced should be published. This email included instructions for how Heads of Profession could provide their statistical releases on the ONS web publishing team for publication on the ONS backup website.
- The ONS publishing team experienced some unexpected technical issues with their backup web site on the morning of 23 March 2017 but despite this they were still able to publish all the statistics received from other government departments between 09:34 and 11:17 that morning, minimising the impact on users.
- ONS provided a URL for each publication, for departments to share directly with their stakeholders and users.
