2. Circumstances of breach

The publication was set-up on the CCEA website in advance of the 09:30 hrs release time in accordance with internal guidance but the link to the publication didn't appear on the website until 10:20 hrs. We realised shortly after 10:00 hrs that the link hadn't appeared and we raised the matter with the CCEA staff member responsible for the upload to the website. This was due to a human oversight.		

3. Impact of the breach

This has had limited impact as statistics were published within the hour and we received no complaints.

4. Corrective actions (taken or planned) to prevent re-occurrence

The processes have been updated to reflect this need to ensure future publications being made available at 09:30 hrs exactly. A new desktop procedure has been created to ensure this risk will be mitigated in the future. The procedure includes oversight by multiple staff and computer automation. And has been circulated to the relevant teams.
