4. Corrective actions (taken or planned) to prevent re-occurrence

The failure was investigated but we do not have sufficient logging or data in the relevant components of the publishing system to identify and fully understand the particular issue which caused this breach.

Additional and more detailed logging will be implemented in the publishing system to allow us to improve our ability to capture, diagnose and help resolve such errors should they reoccur.

Longer term, changes to our publishing process design will remove the affected components.
