Impact of the breach

The pre-release was sent out this morning 9.30am. An approved pre-release recipient from the Department for Education (DfE) informed us in the afternoon that they had mistakenly sent a summary of main trends to an individual at DfE who was not on the pre-release list (along with a few others who were on the pre-release access list).

We were also informed that the individual who should not have received the summary have confirmed that they have deleted the email.

Because this person was notified and deleted the email soon after receiving it, and because only a summary of main trends was sent, there should be minimal negative impact of the breach.

Corrective actions (taken or planned) to prevent re-occurrence

Describe the short-term actions made to redress the situation and the longer-term changes to procedures:

The person who mistakenly sent the summary has been reminded of the need to maintain confidentiality as per the pre-release conditions in the future. We will also look to strengthen the text that we send out as part of the pre-release process.
